

**Junior Regatta
Bray Sailing Club
Thursday 21st July 2016**



NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is Bray Sailing Club (BSC), The Harbour, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

Rules

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and this notice of race. ISAF Regulation 20 will apply.

Conditions of Entry

Boats shall be entered by a member of a club, or other organisation, affiliated to a member national authority of ISAF. Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property, or loss of property, attach to the Trustees, Officers, Committee, Race Committee, or Members of Bray Sailing Club.

All competitors shall be aged 19 years or under on 31st December 2016.

The boat's owner or authorised representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by adequate Third Party Indemnity Insurance. All competitors and race officials who are not members of Bray Sailing Club will be automatically members of the Club for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the Club.

Classes

Racing will be provided for all Dinghies, including Picos, sailing as a PY Handicap fleet. Classes with 10 or more entries may be given a separate start. Lasers Standards, Radials and 4.7s may sail as one Laser Handicap fleet. The composition of fleets will be at the entire discretion of the organising authority, and will be posted within 15 minutes of the close of registration, i.e. by 1015hrs on 21st July 2016.

Registration and Entry Fee

Registration will take place in the Race Office, Bray Sailing Club on Thursday 21st July from 0900hrs to 1000hrs. The entry fee will be €5 per competitor. The entry fee includes a BBQ after sailing.

Entry Limits

An entry limit may be imposed by the organisers, based on the availability of rescue cover. Should entries need to be capped, entries will be accepted in the order in which they are received.

Schedule of Races

Up to 4 races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race will be at 1130hrs on Thursday 21st July 2016.

Courses

Details of the courses to be sailed, and class flags to be used, will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring System

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Tides

Bray Harbour dries out at low water. There is enough water at the slip for launching and retrieving boats 3 hours each side of high water for dinghies, and around 2 hours for keel boats.
