NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is Bray Sailing Club (BSC), The Harbour, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

Rules

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and this notice of race. World Sailing Regulation 20 will apply.

Conditions of Entry

Boats shall be entered by a member of a club, or other organisation, affiliated to a member national authority of World Sailing.

Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property, or loss of property, attach to the Trustees, Officers, Committee, Race Committee, or Members of Bray Sailing Club.

The boat's owner or representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by adequate Third Party Indemnity Insurance.

All competitors and race officials who are not members of Bray Sailing Club will be automatically members of the Club for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the Club.

Classes

Racing will be provided for all Dinghies, including Flying 15s and Picos, sailing as a PY Handicap fleet. Classes with 10 or more entries may be given a separate start. Lasers Standards, Radials and 4.7s may sail as one Laser Handicap fleet. The composition of fleets will be at the entire discretion of the organising authority, and will be posted within 10 minutes of the close of registration.

Payment, Registration and Entry Fee

Registration will take place in the Club House, Bray Sailing Club on **Wednesday 20th June between 1800hrs and 1930hrs and on Thursday 21st June between 1630hrs and 1730hrs only.**

The entry fee will be €40 for adult double handed boats, €20 for adult single-handed classes.

The entry fee for Competitors who are 21 years of age or younger at the date of entry will be €20 for crewed boats and €10 for single-handed boats.

For those sailing under 18 years of age on the first day of the event, a parent's or guardian's signature is required on the entry form.

An entry limit may be imposed by the Race Committee in order to provide adequate safety boat cover. Entries will be accepted in the order in which they are received with full payment.

Schedule of Races

Up to 9 races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race of each day will be at 1915 on Thursday 21st June, at 1930 on Friday 22nd June, and at 1830 on Saturday 23rd June 2018.

Courses

Details of the courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring System

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising authority.

Tides

Bray Harbour dries out at low water. There is enough water at the slip for launching and retrieving boats 3 hours each side of high water. Neap Tides, Thursday 21st June HW 1922hrs
