NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is Bray Sailing Club (BSC), The Harbour, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

Rules

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and this notice of race. ISAF Regulation 20 will apply.

Conditions of Entry

Boats shall be entered by a member of a club, or other organisation, affiliated to a member national authority of ISAF.

Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property, or loss of property, attach to the Trustees, Officers, Committee, Race Committee, or Members of Bray Sailing Club.

The boat's owner or representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by adequate Third Party Indemnity Insurance.

All competitors and race officials who are not members of Bray Sailing Club will be automatically members of the Club for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the Club.

Classes

Racing will be provided for all Dinghies, including Flying 15s. Classes with 6 or more entries may be given a separate start. Lasers Standards, Radials and 4.7s may sail as one Laser Handicap fleet. The composition of fleets will be at the entire discretion of the organising authority, and will be posted prior to the competitors' briefing on Saturday .

Registration and Entry Fee

Registration will take place in the Race Office, Bray Sailing Club on **Saturday 12th August from 10:00 to 12:30** :

Crewed adult boats 30 euro – Double handed / (15 for single-handed boats)

Junior (U21 or student) 20 euro – Double handed / (10 for single-handed boats)

Entry Limits and Declaration of Intention to Compete.

Competitors shall declare their intention to compete by communicating their sail number, class and name by text to **087 202 5422** or by e-mail to crewman.99@hotmail.com before 10:00 on Saturday 12th August. The number of entries for which patrol boats will be provided will be posted on the BSC website before 12:00 on Friday 5th August.

If this limit is reached, entrants may not be accepted based on safety grounds – decision of race committee is final.

Schedule of Races

Up to 6 races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race will be at 13:45 on Saturday 12th August and at 14:15 on Sunday 13th August . A competitors briefing will be held at 11:30 on Saturday.

Courses

Details of the courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

Scoring System

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

Tides

Bray Harbour dries out at low water. There is enough water at the slip for launching and retrieving keel boats around 2 hours each side of high water, dinghies about 3 hours.

High Water on Saturday 12th August 15:31 and 16:16 on Sunday 13th August.
