## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CAREFULLY BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION

1. Bray Sailing Club is a recognised Training Centre accredited by Irish Sailing. All courses offered are approved & inspected by Irish Sailing to ensure that the club's courses are complying with Irish Sailing guidelines. Visit [www.sailing.ie](http://www.sailing.ie) for more info.
2. Our child safety policy can be found at [www.braysailingclub.ie/Membership/Constitution-Rules-and-Bye-Laws](http://www.braysailingclub.ie/Membership/Constitution-Rules-and-Bye-Laws)
3. Attendance at a course does not guarantee that a participant will achieve that level.
4. Participants are not permitted to bring any alcohol, matches, lighters, or weapons of any kind to the club.
5. All participants must be aged 8 years or over on 01/05/2019 and should be comfortable in water out of their depth. They should also be able to tread water for 2 minutes and be able to hold their head under water for 10 seconds. If you are providing your own boat, it will be checked before use.
6. Each child is responsible for providing their own clothing for sailing in e.g. wetsuit, buoyancy aid, cagoule and appropriate footwear on the water e.g. runners, wetsuit boots.
7. Places on courses are limited as we must adhere to a strict instructor-trainee ratio. Places will be allocated strictly on a first come, first served basis. Applications for places are only valid when submitted with payment. Once an application has been accepted and a place on a course allocated, we regret that fees cannot be refunded. If the club is unable to accept an application for any reason, any fees paid will be refunded.
8. For a sailing course to be as effective as possible, trainees should be on the water as often as possible. Unfortunately with as weather can be unpredictable, this is not always possible and we aim to provide relevant shore-based tuition during periods of inclement weather.
9. Course participants under 13 are not allowed to leave the confines of Bray Harbour and Bray Sailing Club at any time during the day. Over 13's can only do so, if written permission has been provided by their parents. Participants should bring a healthy packed lunch with them every day
10. All participants are expected to play their part in the effective running of the course. This means participating willingly, following the instructions of instructors, supporting other participants, taking turns to clean showers and changing rooms and being respectful, polite and friendly to instructors, other club members, and fellow course members.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS Cont'd.

11. In keeping with the family ethos of the club, we also require parents to play their part in the effective and cost efficient running of our courses. **To this end, each child attending a course will have a parent (or other suitable adult) rostered for either two half days or one full day's duty as "Shore Parent"**. This is an essential safety role and does not require you to go on the water. Please bear this in mind when booking courses.
12. Any participant who is found to have "borrowed" another participant's property without permission will be asked to leave the course immediately.
13. Bullying in any form is strictly prohibited, this includes spreading rumours, name calling and exclusion as well as the more obvious forms

## CONSENT & WAIVER

I accept that my child's participation in the club's activities, is at my sole and exclusive risk and responsibility in every respect. I acknowledge that the Club, its trustees, officers, staff and members have no responsibility in respect of loss of life, injury or loss of or damage to property that my child or any other person may sustain arising from participation or intended participation howsoever arising.

If applicable, I confirm that my child's boat is insured against third party liability for a minimum of €1,300,000 to cover my liability in connection with my child's participation on the course and for the period it is parked in the Club. Also, if my child's boat is a double-hander, I agree that other trainees have permission to sail in our boat with the owner of the boat, as assigned by an instructor.

If it becomes necessary for my child to receive medical treatment during the course and I am not contactable by telephone, I hereby give my consent to any necessary medical treatment and authorise the Senior Instructor in charge or a member of Bray Sailing Club's management team to sign any document required by the medical authorities.

I understand & agree that my child might be photographed and that these photographs might be used by the club and/or might be uploaded onto the club's various social media sites e.g. Whatsapp, Facebook, etc.

I understand & agree that my child might occasionally be contacted directly by sailing club officials and instructors in relation to club matters.
