### **NOTICE OF RACE**

The organising authority is Bray Sailing Club (BSC), The Harbour, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

#### **RULES**

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). ISAF Regulation 20 - Advertising will apply.

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Boats shall be entered by a member of a club, or other organisation, affiliated to a member national authority of ISAF. Each boat must have a valid measurement certificate.

Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property, or loss of property, attach to the Trustees, Officers, Committee, Race Committee, or Members of Bray Sailing Club.

The boat's owner or representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by adequate Third Party Indemnity Insurance

All competitors and race officials who are not members of Bray Sailing Club will be automatically members of the Club for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the Club.

#### **CLASSES**

Racing will be provided for, Enterprises, Lasers (Standard & Radial), Flying Fifteens, RS 400s, Wayfarers, Fast and Slow Handicap. Racing may be provided for other classes if 4 or more boats register. One-design classes that have fewer than 4 registered boats will race in either the Fast or Slow Handicap class. There may be separate starts for each class with a minimum of 5 entries.

Entries received after the official close of registration will not be taken into consideration when the final decision on classes and fleet starts is taken.

#### **REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE**

Registration entries will take place in the Race Office, Bray Sailing Club on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July from 09.00 to 10.00 hours.

The entry fee will be 50 euro for crewed boats and 30 euro for single-handed boats.

Sailing instructions will be available on registration.

The entry fee for Competitors who are 21 years of age or younger at the date of entry will be €30 for crewed boats and €20 for single-handed boats.

The entry fee will include Burgers after sailing on Saturday.

#### **ENTRY LIMITS AND DECLARATION OF INTENTION TO COMPETE.**

Competitors shall declare their intention to compete by communicating their sail number, class and name by text to **0861622170** or by e-mail to [lfegan@mjp.ie](mailto:lfegan@mjp.ie) before 12.00 on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July. The number of entries for which patrol boats will be provided will be posted on the BSC website before 0900 on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July. Competitors who have not declared their intention to compete may only register up to the declared entry limit.

#### **SCHEDULE OF RACES**

6 races are scheduled. The warning signal for the first race will be at 11.00 Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> July.

#### **COURSES**

Details of the courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

#### **SCORING SYSTEM**

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A shall apply, except that when fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

#### **PRIZES**

Prizes will be awarded on the basis of turn out for each class.
