## NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is Bray Sailing Club (BSC), The Harbour, Bray, Co. Wicklow.

### RULES

The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the Irish Sailing Association, the ECHO handicap system, the Sailing Instructions (SIs) and this notice of race.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Boats shall be entered by a member of a club or other organisation affiliated to a member national authority of ISAF

Boats registered for club racing at BSC will use their current club handicap. All other boats must present an ECHO certificate or a written declaration from their club of the current handicap attributed to the boat.

Entries are accepted on the basis that in no circumstances will any liability for injury to person(s) or property, or loss of property, attach to the Officers, Trustees, Committee, Race Committee, or Members of Bray Sailing Club.

The boat's owner or representative must sign a declaration on the Entry Form that his/her boat is covered by a policy of Third Party Indemnity Insurance of not less than 3,000,000 euro.

All competitors and race officials who are not members of Bray Sailing Club will be automatically members of the Club for the duration of the event and will be subject to the rules of the Club.

### CLASSES

Racing will be provided for Cruisers 1 and Cruisers 2. There may be separate starts for each class.

### REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

Registration of entries will take place in the Race Office, Bray Sailing Club, on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> August between 10.00am and 11.00am. The Entry Fee will be €25 per boat. Sailing Instructions will be available on registration.

### SCHEDULE OF RACES

Three short races are scheduled on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> August. The warning signal for the first race will be at 12.30 hours.

Two longer races are scheduled for Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> August.

The schedule of races is subject to change.

### COURSES

Details of the courses to be sailed will be contained in the Sailing Instructions.

### SCORING SYSTEM

The races shall be scored as provided in Appendix A of the RRS (2009-2012) using the Low Points System. If all scheduled races are sailed, there will be a discard of 1 race. Series ties will be broken using the following in this order:-

- (1) A8.1 (Most best scores excluding discards)
- (2) A8.2 (Best score in last race)
- (3) Tie remains

### PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the top 3 places overall in Cruisers 1 and Cruisers 2. Other prizes may also be awarded. Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after Sunday racing.

### TIDES

Bray Harbour dries out at low water. There is enough water at the slip for launching and retrieving boats for approximately 3 hours each side of high water.
