Bray Sailing Club – Safety Statement

It is the policy of this Club to comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act, 1989 and the relevant regulations and to ensure as far as reasonably practicable, the safety, health and welfare of all members/employees while at activities/work, and to provide such information, training and supervision needed for this purpose.

It is policy of this Club to protect, as far as is reasonably practicable, persons who are not members of the Club who may be affected by our activities.

While this responsibility deals with the individual's personal safety, there is a wider responsibility that affects others. To this end every member is required to behave in a manner that promotes general welfare and ensures that his/her actions will take care of the safety of others as well as taking care of the Club's property and equipment.

The policy will be kept up to date particularly as the activities change in nature and size. To ensure this, the policy and the way which it is operated, will be reviewed as required.
